## CONVENTIONAL SOYBEAN PRODUCTION IN BRAZIL

- MARKET NICHE BRAZIL STILL HAS SOME FARMERS INTERESTED IN SUPPLYING THE INTERNATIONAL DEMAND FOR CONVENTIONAL SOYBEAN (GRAINS AND SUBPRODUCTS)
  - AREA, KNOW-HOW, HIGHLY PRODUCTIVE COMMERCIAL VARIETIES
- INTERNATIONAL AND BRAZILIAN SOYBEAN TRADINGS ARE SUPPORTING THE PRODUCTION AND INDUSTRIAL NON-GM SOYBEAN CHAIN
- DIFFERENTIATED AND PROFITABLE MARKET FOR THE PRODUCTION CHAIN
- EMBRAPA HAS A STRONG CONVENTIONAL SOYBEAN BREEDING PROGRAM, WITH TOP CULTIVARS AVAILABLE IN THE MARKET AND IS COMMITTED TO KEEP DEVELOPING NEW AND IMPROVED CULTIVARS
- WITH TIME IT COULD BE MORE DIFFICULT TO KEEP THE PURITY OF THE LINES WHICH MEANS THAT A GOOD STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM MUST BE IN PLACE
